This role works closely with and supports the work of the SENDCo to help raise standards of achievement across all curriculum areas. The Assistant SENDCo will be an operational lead for Provision in the Education team.

As Assistant SENDCo and Provision Lead you will support inclusion work within the school by working closely with the SENDCo, Clinical Lead, teaching, and senior staff to provide specialist support/advice to ensure that students' needs are met and barriers to learning are overcome. You will lead EHCP annual reviews. In addition, the post holder will also be expected to work with and provide specialist support to individual students and groups of students.

This is a great opportunity for a SEN Teacher who wants to improve outcomes for pupils with varied and complex needs. Your work will be challenging and rewarding in equal measure, and you will be working in a school where we maintain a strong safeguarding culture; where pupils are listened to, respected and involved in as many decisions as possible.
