Specific responsibilities for: Leading the planning and delivery of Construction lessons at Options Trent Acres School.

Purpose of the Job:

To take a leading role in teaching Construction

To work with senior leaders to develop the curriculum and introduce new qualification pathways in Construction.

To work under the guidance of SLT to raise the standard of Construction lessons across the school.

Select and use a range of different resources and teaching styles, appropriate to the workshop.

Promote positive management of behaviour in the workshop environment, establish routines and boundaries to ensure the safety and good behaviour of the children.

Key Areas:

- To monitor and support the teaching and learning throughout Construction.
- Under the direction of the Deputy Headteacher, ensure Construction curriculum is implemented, monitored and reviewed in order to analyse its effectiveness.
- To have a solid understanding of the school pathways and ensuring suitable learning is taking place in all environments.
- Deliver enrichment and enhancement activities.
- To have an understanding of appropriate vocational qualifications and ensure pupils are working towards these in key stage 4 and key stage 5.
- To ensure the health and safety of all participants, including writing and checking risk assessments for the sites, tools and activities used.
- To regularly check and maintain tools and other equipment.
- Liaise with the Deputy Head Teacher and the Senior Leadership team to communicate subject effectiveness and how this impacts the school.
- To model professional standards at all times in line with Professional Standards for Teachers.
