JOB ROLE & PURPOSE

Deliver expert-led, high-impact Occupational Therapy directly within mainstream school environments. You will lead school cluster-wide, whole-school, and group interventions to overcome barriers to learning, participation, and independence. This role combines advanced clinical practice in sensory, motor, and functional skills with strategic school consultation.

In line with the seniority of this post, the post holder may be required to support the multi-disciplinary team in a locality role to ensure activity meets the agreed expectation of the head of clinical operations. You will be required to undertake delegated line management of others within the clinical team, where deemed necessary by the clinical lead and Director of Clinical Operations, as well as support clinical supervision of junior staff. You will work closely with your team to create a responsive service in the schools/clinics where you work, and to ensure that wherever possible, evidence-based practice is delivered in line with

Momenta Connect and OFG policies and guidelines. As part of the multi-disciplinary team, you will provide highly specialist advice, information and training to staff, other members of the multi-disciplinary team and other agencies regarding the scope of OT practice, including individuals who present with behaviours that challenge, to support engagement in meaningful activity and to encourage independence.

This role requires highly specialist assessment and treatment of complex cases. You will require at least 5 years of work experience, with evidence of a specialism in advanced practice and study. As a registered practitioner, you are personally responsible for your self-directed learning and for CPD. You will be expected to hold a full caseload in a busy service, with clinical supervision from a highly specialist or consultant occupational therapist.

As part of your role, you will be responsible for developing bespoke programmes for occupational therapist assistants, teachers and carers. Your clinical duties will include supervising, preparing and delivering training, attending forums, and completing audits and risk assessments, all within the ethical framework provided by the rules of professional conduct.

Key Areas and Responsibilities

1. Clinical & Operational Leadership

- **Direct** the clinical and operational delivery of the Experts At Hand model across London Boroughs.
- **Lead and manage** the regional occupational therapy team, including therapists and assistants.
- **Monitor** service delivery metrics, evaluate clinical outcomes, and drive continuous service development.
- **Oversee** referral screening, case management allocations, complex clinical risks, and corporate reporting.
- **Participate** in and lead multi-disciplinary meetings, collaborating with the Clinical Lead on formal reporting.

2. Specialist Clinical Practice & School Integration

- **Implement** a graduated response model embedding physical, sensory, and functional expertise school-wide.
- **Conduct** highly specialist occupational therapy assessments for children with diverse, complex presentations.
- **Identify** barriers to educational engagement using advanced task analysis and environmental reflection.
- **Formulate** evidence-based intervention plans heavily integrated into statutory Education, Health and Care Plans (EHCPs).
- **Deliver** evidence-based clinical intervention and build experts at hand within practice to through training and foster embedded approaches in an educational setting.
- **Advise** school leadership and train teachers on sensory-friendly environments and universal strategies.
- **Design** and model targeted small-group interventions to empower education staff for independent delivery.

3. Workforce Management, Supervision & Training

- **Coordinate** multidisciplinary working and promote cohesive team communication across the service.
- **Line-manage** staff by undertaking probation reviews, return-to-work meetings, appraisals, and sickness monitoring.
- **Supervise** occupational therapists and assistants in accordance with regulatory body standards.
- **Deliver** specialist advice, peer mentoring, and evaluated in-service training to all internal employees.
- **Provide** specialist clinical presentations, training, and consultation services to external partner agencies.
- **Facilitate** high-quality clinical training placements for students and provide formal feedback to universities.

4. Professional Standards, Safeguarding & Governance

- **Model** best practice aligned with the RCOT Code of Conduct and HCPC Standards of Proficiency.
- **Embed** an OT-based clinical framework across the team via dedicated supervision and knowledge dissemination.
- **Support** the Head of Service with policy development and evidence-based practice updates.
- **Execute** robust safeguarding procedures, directing supervisees through corporate child protection protocols.
- **Adhere** to company, infection control, risk management, and Health & Safety guidelines, mitigating hazards immediately.
- **Maintain** precise clinical records and reports across designated electronic platforms and adhere to GDPR codes of practice and policies.
- **Operate** within agreed service budgets as instructed by corporate leadership.

5. Research, Evaluation & Environmental Adaptation

- **Measure** service efficacy using evidence-based practice projects, clinical audits, and outcome measures.
- **Engage** key stakeholders within assigned settings and report feedback directly to the Head of Service.
- **Adapt** to unpredictable educational environments, fluid work patterns, deadlines, and frequent interruptions.
- **Deliver** an agreed job plan balancing intervention, group work, consultation, and management tasks.
- **Communicate** potentially distressing or sensitive clinical information to families with high empathy.
- **Manage** personal performance by setting targeted development objectives for annual appraisals.
- **Execute** additional reasonable duties requested by the Clinical Locality Lead or Head of Clinical Operations.
